

FLEE FROM THE FOOLISHNESS OF MAN

1Pet.2:15 For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the **ignorance of foolish men**:

Prv.19:29 Judgments are prepared for scorners, and **stripes** for the back of fools.

Ps.107:17 Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted.

Prv.17:12 Let a bear robbed of her whelps meet a man, rather than a fool in his folly.

Prv.13:19 The desire accomplished is sweet to the soul: but it is abomination to fools **to depart from evil**.

STRIVE WITH GOD

- Is 45:9 Woe unto him that **striveth with his Maker!** Let the potsherd strive with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay say to him that fashioneth it, What makest thou? or thy work, He hath no hands?
- Job 1:22 In all this Job sinned not, **nor charged God** foolishly.
- Deut.32:6 Do ye thus **requite the LORD**, O foolish people and unwise? is not he thy father that hath bought thee? hath he not made thee, and established thee?
- Job 37:23 Touching the Almighty, we cannot **find him out**: he is excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice: he will not afflict.
- Ps.74:18 Remember this, that the enemy hath reproached, O LORD, and that the foolish people have **blasphemed thy name**.
- Eccl.7:24 That which is far off, and exceeding deep, who can **find it out**?

TEMPT GOD

- Ex.17:2 Wherefore the people did **chide with Moses**, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said unto them, Why chide ye with me? wherefore do ye **tempt the LORD**?
:7 And he called the name of the place **Massah**(tempt), and **Meribah**(rebel), because of the chiding of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the LORD, saying, Is the LORD among us, or not?
- Deut. 6:16 Ye shall **not tempt the LORD** your God, as ye tempted him in **Massah**
- Prv.11:27 He that diligently seeketh good procureth favour: but **he that seeketh mischief, it shall come** unto him.

REJECT CORRECTION:

- Prv.12:15 The way of a fool is **right in his own eyes**: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel is wise.
- Prv.14:16 A wise man feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool **rageth**, and is **confident**.
- Prv.10:8 The wise in heart will **receive commandments**: but a prating(empty chatter) fool shall fall.

QUICK WRATH:

- Prv.12:16 A fool's wrath is **presently known**: but a prudent man covereth shame.
- Prv.14:17 He that is **soon angry** dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.
- Job 5:2 For wrath **killeth** the foolish man, and envy slayeth the silly one.
- Prv.9:13 A foolish woman is **clamorous**: she is simple, and knoweth nothing.

DAMAGE HOME:

- Prv.14:1 Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish **plucketh** it down with her hands
- Prv.18:2 A fool hath no delight in understanding, but that his **heart** may discover itself.

FORNICATION:

- Prv.7:22 He goeth after her straightway, as an ox goeth to the **slaughter**, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks;
- Proverbs 28:26 He that **trusteth in his own heart** is a fool: but whoso walketh wisely, he shall be delivered.
- Ps.38:5 My **wounds** stink and are corrupt because of my foolishness.

REJOICE IN SIN:

- Prv.14:9 Fools make a **mock** at sin: but among the righteous there is favour
- Luke 12:20 But God said unto him, Thou fool, **this night thy soul shall be required of thee**: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

HATE KNOWLEDGE:

- Prv.1:22 How long, ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity? and the scorers delight in their scorning, and fools **hate knowledge**?
- Prv.1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools **despise wisdom and instruction**.

LABEL EVERYONE A FOOL

- Eccl.10:3 Yea also, when he that is a fool walketh by the way, his wisdom faileth him, and he **saith to every one that he is a fool**.
- Mth 5:22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of **hell fire**.

BURDEN PARENTS

- Prv.10:1 The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother.

UTTERETH SLANDER

- Prv.10:18 He that hideth hatred with lying lips, and he that uttereth a **slander**, is a fool.

FOOLISHNESS OPENLY

- Prv.13:16 Every prudent man dealeth with knowledge: but a fool **layeth open his folly**.

STUBBORNESS

- Prv.17:10 A reproof entereth more into a wise man than an hundred stripes into a fool.

PRIDE

- Prv.14:3 In the mouth of the foolish is a **rod of pride**: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them.
- Proverbs 30:32 If thou hast done foolishly in lifting up thyself, or if thou hast thought evil, lay thine hand upon thy mouth

CONTENTIOUS

- Prv.18:6 A fool's lips enter into **contention**, and his mouth calleth for strokes.

UNPREPARED FOR LOSS

- Prv.21:20 There is treasure to be desired and oil in the dwelling of the wise; but a foolish man **spendeth it up**

SLUGGARD

- Prv.26:16 The sluggard is **wiser in his own conceit** than seven men that can render a reason.
- Eccl.4:5 The fool foldeth his hands together, and eateth his own flesh
- Prv.13:4 The soul of the **sluggard** desireth, and hath nothing: but the soul of the diligent shall be made fat.

UNGODLY RICH

- Jer.17:11 As the partridge sitteth on eggs, and hatcheth them not; so he that getteth riches, and **not by right**, shall leave them in the midst of his days, and at his end shall be a fool

ANSWERING QUICKLY

- Prv.18:13 He that answereth a matter **before he heareth it**, it is folly and shame unto him.

TELLS ALL

- Prv.29:11 A fool uttereth **all his mind**: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards.

DESPISE PARENTS

- Prv.15:20 A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish man **despiseth his mother**.

BUSYBODIES

- Prv.20:3 It is an honour for a man to cease from strife: but every fool will be meddling

- Eccl.5:3 For a dream cometh through the multitude of business; and a fool's voice is known by multitude of words.

ATHEISM:

- Ps.14:1 The fool hath said in his heart, There is **no God**. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good. Grip of Sin:
- Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they **glorified him not** as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was **darkened**.

.....

Ps.92:6 A brutish man knoweth not; neither doth a fool understand this.

Prv.10:23 It is as sport to a fool to do mischief: but a man of understanding hath wisdom.

Prv.14:33 Wisdom resteth in the heart of him that hath understanding: but that which is in the midst of fools is made known

Prv15:5 A fool despiseth his father's instruction: but he that regardeth reproof is prudent

Prv.26:8 As he that bindeth a stone in a sling, so is he that giveth honour to a fool.

Prv.26:11 As a dog returneth to his vomit, so a fool returneth to his folly.

Eccl.7:9 Be not hasty in thy spirit to be angry: for anger resteth in the bosom of fools.

Eccl. 10:14 A fool also is full of words: a man cannot tell what shall be; and what shall be after him, who can tell him?

1 Corinthians 15:36 Thou fool, that which thou sowest is not quickened, except it die:

Gal.3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?

Prv.26:4 Answer not a fool according to his folly, lest thou also be like unto him.

Prv.26:5 Answer a fool according to his folly, lest he be wise in his own conceit
